

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To view your Panther Degree Audit:

1. Click the “Academic Advising” tile, then click on the “Degree Audit” tile, then finally click on “Panther Degree Audit.”

How to Read Your Panther Degree Audit:

1. Status Symbols:

- Taken:** Courses that have been previously taken.
- In Progress:** Currently enrolled courses.
- Planned:** You can plan your courses ahead of time and they will be displayed on your PDA.
