



Meeting Minutes August 19, 2020

Meeting called to session at 3:03 pm

Registrar's Office

- → MDC summer grades and degrees Dulce Beltran
 - MDC summer term B and C end on August 21st.
 - This presents a short time to transition to FIU
 - o There are 2583 students pending electronic transfers from MDC
 - These will be released on Monday, August 24th
 - Expected to be at FIU on Wednesday, August 26th grades only, no degrees posted
 - A new transcript request will be sent on September 1st (could be at an earlier or later date), which hopefully will include posted degrees.
- → Delayed On Campus Start (DOCS) modality **Dulce Beltran**
 - It is new and in production today (August 19th)
 - o Emails will be sent out to students tonight
 - o Faculty affected will be emailed as well
 - Hybrid, face-to-face, web-assisted all were changed to DOCS
 - Classes still begin on August 24th but will not begin on campus even if they are face-to-face
 - All undergraduate courses will be changed to DOCS until at least September 14th
 - Information will be on askcharlie.fiu.edu
 - Faculty can opt to remain face-to-face because of the type of class taught
 - 90% of courses are in other modalities
 - o Graduate classes need to opt into DOCS

- These will still be on campus unless faculty request to modify the modality
- o Faculty will get a note on their message board and an email
- → Additional DOCS information Valerie Johnsen
 - 700 undergraduate sections will be moved to DOCS
 - 29 graduate sections are opting into DOCS
 - The idea is to lower the density of students on campus
 - In 3 weeks, the situation may be safer to increase the density of students on campus
 - DOCS will show up as an actual modality (D)
- → Auto-graduation German Cruz
 - 2698 degrees were posted
 - As of summer, all colleges except Engineering and CARTA are live.
- → Chosen First Name Policy German Cruz
 - It's live on PantherSoft
 - Chosen pronouns are only on Campus Solutions at the moment
 - Check this when using in communication to students
 - http://develop.fiu.edu has a training on Chosen First Name and Pronouns policy
