- Gali Milbauer, Block Cohort Program. Structured program, Vice-Provost's initiative. Four programs, 2 Business, 1 Hospitality, 1 Psych. Business #s low, about 3 students. Psych is at 15; Gaby from Hospitality reported they are at 10 or so. Students take courses from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. No courses will be scheduled on Tuesdays or Thursdays. Pilot is with FTIC only, might extend it to transfers. Dean Rowan asked that we all promote this initiative.
- Stephen Anderson, Professional Development Update. 22 weeks into the initiative (backdated to July 1, officially started Sept). Has met with all 9702 advisors academic advisors who have dual reporting structures, report to college and UE (Steve Anderson). 2/3 of all advisors are 9702.
 Goal is to switch everyone over. PDUS = Avg across campus is about 38 should be about 42 PDUs. Steve displayed reports at advisor level, college level, etc. so all could see how progress is being made.

- Charlie Andrews He and Connie Boronat met with Math dept to work on improving MGF1106 passing rate. 1. Math department will be converting 5 1106 sections to 1107; 20% higher

- passing rate in 1107 than in 1106. 1106 better paired with majors with statistics requirement. 1107 for others. Problem has usually been that they run out of 1107 sections first.
- Jamie from NSE recruiting students to participate more in the exchange program. Sent interested students to her.
- Change of Major discussion. Non-limited majors should be switched automatically. Some majors
 not letting students declare major because student does not have a 2.0 gpa. Work on
 developing an improved process.
- Hospitality will raise their gpa to 2.75 effective Fall 2014.
