## • Mandatory Transfer Orientation and Registration

-New service indicator issued; suggestions were made for name abbreviation for service indicator (TRD; TRA, etc). Reviewed flow chart of process. Each college was to email Korrin to verify advising process for transfer advising and registration day. Encouraged participation on Saturday and evening. Discussion of possible integration with Admissions Transfer Tuesdays, to be revisited.

# New UCC Updates

-New UCC courses added constantly, work in progress. New UCC honors link to be worked out (which Honors courses will count towards new UCC categories). Long discussion about making sure procedures and processes in place for transient process.

#### • First Year Cohort Retention Outreach

-84% of 2014 FTIC cohort retained from Fall to Spring 2015 (with GPA of at least a 2.0). This is up 3% from last year and highest in 9 years. Discussed ways that advisors are reaching out to students. CAS gave brief overview of their process and forms.

### Early Alert Update

-Early Alerts tab went live on Jan. 19t. By this meeting, there were 1598 total alerts triggered by instructors across campus. 1353 were issued by instructors of non-Title V course. Brief discussion of process and advisor involvement.

## My College Scheduler Update

-Staged cart that advisor can create alongside student is now available. Student can then import to their actual shopping cart. Page dedicated to MyCourseScheduler along with tutorial video and manual available on OneStop website. Communication will be sent to students beginning in mid-March.

Transfer – working on slides for transfer orientation that could be used by all colleges, transfer data reports.
