Model USAID Bill

Senator Mikele Mancuso introduced the following bill, which was presented on the Senate floor

A BILL

To appropriate \$1,512.80 for the purpose of providing food and beverages in the form of lunch bags and water to participants of a Model USAID event held on November 16th, 2023.

Be it enacted by the Senate of the Student Body at Florida International University assembled,

Whereas, Model USAID will be an event held at FIU in collaboration between FIU’s Steven J. Green School for International and Public Affairs and the Student Government Association;

Whereas, Model USAID is an event which will act as both a learning opportunity for students interested in International Development and a networking opportunity for like-minded students and professionals in USAID;

Whereas, Model USAID will be held on Nov. 16th from 9:00AM to 5:00PM in SASC 160;

Whereas, The Student Government Association plans to promote the event on social media, given that the Green school provide the flyer to be displayed;

Whereas, the Model USAID event expects between 75 – 90 student participants to attend, not including any invited guests which can include but are not limited to FIU faculty and staff and USAID officials/representatives;

Whereas, the Model USAID event plans to use the intended appropriated funds totaling \$1,512.80 to purchase 100 “Express bags” for \$1,405.00 and 4 water dispensers with 5 gallons of water in each dispenser for \$107.80, all from Panther Catering;

Now Therefore, the Senate of the Student Body resolves to expend \$1,512.80 from the Legislative Branch Line Item of the Student Government Association for the purpose of providing food and beverages in the form of lunch bags and water to participants of a Model USAID event held on November 16th, 2023.
