 - 7. Senator Fogel suggestion a survey is sent out to see what the best option is. Senator Raggio suggested against that. Most students do not fill out surveys emailed to them
 - 8. Senator Gaynor moved to end debate, Senator seconds. Motion passed unanimously. Debate ends
