IX. Unfinished Business

- A. SB 03 013: The Sustainability Fair Act
 - 1. The bill was read out loud
 - 2. A 3-min Q&A session was opened
 - Senator Cicconi asked why the Young Democratic Socialists of America (YDSA) was being allowed to table at this event
 - 4. Senator Columna said that the GC lawns are a public area and that any group can table as long as they have a permit
 - 5. Senator Hernandez said the Office of Sustainability is in charge of inviting groups to table at the event, but were unaware of any statements made by YDSA
 - 6. Senator Sutton extended the Q&A by 2 minutes
 - 7. Senator Gaynor asked how they came up with the total cost
 - 8. Senator Rodriguez said there was an error and the original total did not match up with the amount in the meeting minutes
 - 9. Senator Cicconi asked about the requirements to table
 - 10. Senator King said the events is about promoting sustainable practices, not about the political practices of different groups
 - 11. Senator Tunon moved to enter a 7-min discussion
 - 12. The motion is seconded. Motion passed
 - 13. Senator Tunon said the whole point of the fair is to promote sustainable practices

- 14. Senator Tunon said that he doesn't agree with the beliefs of YDSA but does not have a problem with them being there
- 15. Senator Rodriguez said that this bill is only to appropriate funds, and it is not related to which groups are going to be present
- 16. Senator Cicconi said he will not vote in favor of this bill
- 17. Senator Loiseau said that these are all valid concerns but this bill is just an appropriation
- 18. Senator Columna said he does not agree with YDSA but they do not represent the Sustainability Fair
- 19. Senator King said it is not fair to not pass this bill because one group with be there
- 20. Senator Columna moved to extend the discussion by 2 minutes

- A. SR 03 013: The POP Act
 - 1. The resolution was read out loud
 - 2. A 3-min Q&A session was opened
 - 3. Senator Loiseau asked if the senators have considered changing the language
 - 4. Senator Cicconi said he does not want to change the language
 - 5. Senator Gaynor said they are trying to be objective because this is only a letter of recommendations to the Board of Trustees (BOT)
 - 6. Senator LaChapelle asked if they reached out to the Victim Empowerment Program (VEP)
 - 7. Senator Cicconi said they reached out to many organizations and FIU PD would be open to collaborating
 - 8. Senator Doss moved to open a 7-min discussion
 - 9. The motion is seconded. Motion passed
 - 10. Senator Doss agrees with this bill but the language is too strong
 - 11. Senator Sutton read out two friendly amendments to this resolution
 - 12. Senator Rodriguez said this content is triggering and needs to have a content warning

- 13. Senator Dawson asked why the last therefore clause does not include the blue lights
- 14. Senator Moya-Palacios said that a Florida statute allows people to carry nonlethal weapons for the purpose of self-defense
- 15. Senator Sutton extended the meeting by 10 minutes
- 16. Senator Tunon said that VEP is not allowed to support these bills, but he agrees to change the language
- 17. Senator LaChapelle said that this is a very sensitive topic and the language needs to be changed
- 18. Senator Cicconi moved to extend the discussion by 2 minutes
- 19. The motion is seconded. Motion passed
- 20. Senator Sutton said the bottom line is to allow students to carry pepper spray on campus and the language needs to be changed
- 21. Senator Loiseau said that they should still drop the strong language even with a trigger warning
- 22. Senator Loiseau asked if there would be additional research on the costs if the resolution is passed
- 23. Senator Cicconi said this is not a resolution to fund anything, it is a recommendation to the BOT
- 24. Senator Cicconi said he would be happy to include some amendments
- 25. Senator Cicconi moved to have a 2-min recess to speak freely
- 26. The motion is seconded. Motion passed
