A. 15 Minute Discussion on Floor Leader Position

Senator Cruz opens the floor to ask other senators what is holding them from voting for the proper candidate

Senator Noel mentions she abstained before because she was not convinced of their ability in being floor leader

Senator Hernandez to motion to have the candidates leave the room and continue the discussion

Senator Cruz asks if extending period of discussion for candidates can help voting for those who were not convinced

Senator Vogel mentions candidates do not need more than 2 minutes and they failed to use them wisely

Senator Hernandez says voting should be moved to the next session for senators to think about who to vote

Senator Mancuso mentions both candidates should set themselves apart

Senator Dawson pushes to vote fast to achieve work

 Senator Brochinsky mentions that candidates should open for other ideas
 Senator LaChapelle does not think either candidates can bring something good for the position
 Senator Salup Cid motions to extend discussion by 5 minutes, seconded by senator Dawson
 Senator Cruz encourages others that are discontent with the candidates to nominate themselves for floor leaders
 Senator Arzola asks senate president LaChapelle if not voting for senate floor leader stops from doing other things in the agenda
 Senator Martinez moves to extend for 2-minute discussion, seconded by Senator Del Riesgo
 Senator salup Cid asks to explain the SGA eboard
 President Sutton is recognized and answers
 Senator Arzola moves to continue with the agenda, seconded by senator Dawson
