Senate Marquez moves to go into New Business, Senator Cicconi seconds. Motion Passes VIII. New Business

- A. First Reading of SR 03 002: The International Students Resolution
  - 1. Senate President Sutton reads the resolution. Senate M. Rodriguez moves to open a five-minute discussion, Senator Cicconi seconds the motion.
  - 2. Senator M. Rodriguez is in support of resolution, but her qualm with the resolution is understanding the logistics of the position since not all senate positions are associated with academic units. Senator Cicconi understands that not all senate positions fall under academic unit, how do we determine this for the International Senate position. Student should identify themselves as international students. Senator Cicconi stated he will be making a motion to not allow non-FIU member to sponsor legislation. Senator Moya-Palacios states that not all senators are attached to a degree and is in support of international senate seat. The apportionment is in the constitution and since there about four thousand international students, there could be a international senate seat. Senator Cicconi stated that the Upper and Lower Division senators a lot of students they represent and only one senator, that should not be applied to the international seat. Senator Gaynor stated any seat outside a college does not need to follow that rule.
  - 3. Senator Gaynor moved to previous question; Senator Fogel seconded. Debate on SR 03 002 closed.

B.

Senator Moya-Palacios moved to have a five-minute discussion voting of DACA/Keep Dreaming Resolution, Senator Morizot-Leite seconded. Motions fails.

Senator Cicconi moves to amend the SOP to that only current students, faculty and staff are allowed to sponsor legislation, Senator Fogel seconds. Motion passes.

Senator Cicconi states that in the statutes any non-senator can write legislation. This text would be edited to add student, faculty and staff and not allow non-FIU.

Senator Gaynor aggresses with Senator Cicconi, not FIU affiliated sponsors could set a dangerous precedent.

Senate President Sutton stated that it is important to allow any one and alumni to sponsor.

Point of Inquiry from Senator Hernandez: who would want to do this? Point of Inquiry from Senator Moya Palacios: Does the constitution allow Alumni to sponsor?

Senator Cicconi responded by saying it could be anyone.

Senator Moya-Palacios moves to previous question, Senator Morizot-Leite seconded.
