Sen. Barriga: SGA and RSO to collaborate on CASE event preparation on campus with participation of clubs and organizations under CASE.

Sen. Stone motioned to extend the discussion by 10 minutes, passed.

Sen. Stone: proposes a series on social media with senators recording their experiences to increase awareness about SGA activities.

Sen. Hernandez: April is the Earth Month, a sustainability fare to be scheduled, Climate Action Plan will be developed for FIU. Renovation of the recreation space on the EC proposed.

Sen. Young: more courses proposed for BBC, and more clubs; improving the commute.

Sen. Brochinsky: the phone line improvement is proposed to improve accessibility.

Sen. Lachapelle: lobbying for the student rights in Tallahassee voted on; part of the goal is to collect the student proposals.

Sen. Campbell motioned to extend the discussion by 5 min, passed.

Sen. Campbell: E-board set goals, one of them is lobbying, also improving transportation including the airport shuttle.
