## B. Election of Floor Leader

- 1. Sen. Stone gave an outline of the position
- 2. Sen. Hernandez nominates Sen. Krause, accepted.
- 3. Sen. Sharma nominates Sen. Brochinsky, not accepted.
- 4. Sen. Gedeon nominates himself
- 5. Sen. St. Rose nominates herself
- Sen. Krause gave a speech, believes in the SGA's ability to create positive change, with transparency and accountability. Passionate about sustainability and environmental impact. Have worked within several student organizations
- 7. Sen. Gedeon gave a speech, would like to embrace diversity, believes in the power of unity, committed to inclusivity. Would like to get perspectives for collaboration, believes in the power of working together and unity
- 8. Sen. St. Rose gave a speech, would like to represent LGBTQ students, minorities, and underrepresented students. Takes the needs of others as a priority. Goal is to implement transparent communication and transparent environment
- 9. Sen. Feinberg moves to have a 9-min discussion divided between 3 candidates. Sen. Stone moves to have a 15-min discussion, motion passes.
- 10. Sen. Brochinsky asks about responsibility and accountability in the Senate
  - Sen. Gedeon: takes everything done at the Senate as important Sen. Krause: believes in consequences, can be decided as a group
  - Sen. St. Rose: expectations should be clear, supportive environment is important
- 11. Sen. De Aguilar: asks Sen. Krause about the sustainability focus and how it will relate to the role of the Floor Leader; Sen. Krause: providing support to Senators will be the first priority, would like to collaborate with others on issues to be addressed



12. Sen. Touissant: asks about the candidates' plan to ensure accountability

Sen. Gedeon: there is a need to find reasons and collectively decide on an action

Sen. Krause: accountability is a balance and communication is important, encourages all Senators to fulfill their responsibilities, all should be open and honest about activities and goals Sen. St. Rose: everyone should know the responsibilities and know and follow the rules

- 13. Sen. Stone: gave a scenario about a Senator doing something wrong and the candidates' course of action Sen. Krause: would like to catch the action early, find the reasons and provide support, if action needs to be taken there should be consequences
  - Sen. St. Rose: personal and work balance should be taken into account, Senators need to keep themselves and others accountable
  - Sen. Gedeon: SGA accountable to the student body, Senators should be kept accountable according to their commitment
- 14. Sen. Brochinsky: asked about a conflict of interest understanding Sen. Krause: gave her perspective
  - Sen. St. Rose: would need to separate herself and step back Sen. Gedeon: if there is a personal interest in a matter
- 15. Sen. Hernandez: asked about the meaning of accountability Sen. St. Rose: accountability is about admitting missteps and correcting the problem
  - St. Krause: the structure requires work as a team
- 16. Sen. Stone moves to extend the discussion, motion passes. Sen. Gedeon: accountability is knowing when to say yes, admitting missteps
- 17. Sen. Stone moves to move into a roll call vote, motion passes. With 19 votes for Sen. Gedeon, 8 votes for Sen. Krause and 1 vote for Sen. St. Rose, Sen. Gedeon is elected the Floor Leader.
